FEATURED PRESENTERS

DEBORAH DEAN currently teaches English education and composition courses at Brigham Young University. Prior to teaching at BYU, she taught both junior high and high school in Washington; since moving to Utah, she's also taught writing classes at Provo High. She has articles in English Journal, Voices from the Middle, and Journal of Adolescent and Adult Literacy. Her book, Strategic Writing, was published in 2006 with NCTE, and she has a forthcoming book on teaching grammar with IRA.

LAURA ROBB: Author, teacher, coach, and speaker, this is Laura Robb's 42nd year of teaching in grades 4-8. She presently teaches eighth grade reading/writing workshop at Powhatan School in Virginia and coaches teachers in grades K-8 at Powhatan, in Virginia, Long Island, and New York City. She has written 14 books for teachers. Recently, Robb was nominated to serve a three year term on the National Council of Teacher's of English Commission on Reading. Her term began January, 2003. She's also on the editorial review board for Language Arts magazine. Robb wrote the "Motivating Readers' Column for Instructor Magazine for 1996-1998. She's also collected two poetry anthologies: Snuffles and Snouts (Dial, 1995) and Music and Drum (Philomel, 1997).
