Elementary Education Program Admission Requirements

A BS in Elementary Education leads to licensure in kindergarten through grade six (K-6)

PRE-ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To begin the Elementary Education (EI Ed) teacher preparation program, prospective students should:

1. Declare the Elementary Education Pre-Major. See a program advisor in the Education Advisement Center (EAC), 350 MCKB, (801) 422-3426, educationadvisement@byu.edu
2. Attend a program orientation meeting (see schedule below or pick up a flyer from EAC, 350 MCKB)
3. Review GPA and ACT/SAT scores with a program advisor. Applicants to the program must have:
 - Minimum 3.0 total GPA
 - Minimum 21 composite ACT score (20 English and 19 Math) or 1000 composite SAT score (450 Verbal and 450 Math)
 - If your ACT/SAT scores are below these minimum requirements, you may be able to take the PRAXIS Core test to qualify for admission to the program. The program advisors in EAC can give you more information on this option.

APPLICATION TO THE PROGRAM

1. Register for a free MYLink account and complete the Elementary Education online program application. Applications for admission to the program are submitted electronically through MYLink. <http://mylink.byu.edu>
2. Apply for fingerprinting and FBI background check. Fingerprints are taken in EAC, 350 MCKB. Allow from 1-3 weeks for the fingerprints to be processed. FBI background clearance is valid for 3 years. <http://education.byu.edu/advisement/fingerprint>

3. Complete the Technology Skills Assessment (TSA). TEC lab, 180 MCKB.

4. Complete a graduation plan with a program advisor in the Education Advisement Center, 350 MCKB.
