











Are you Concerned about your Toddler's Language Development?

Researchers at the University of Utah

seek toddlers with language delays to participate in a study investigating language development.

Although most children with language delays do not develop autism, we hope this study will help inform us about how language delays relate to the later development of autism in some children.

Your child may be able to participate if he/she has limited vocalizations by 10-14 months and limited words by 16-20 months.

This study will be conducted over about 2 visits (3-4 hours) at the University of Utah in Salt Lake City, Utah. Participation includes developmental and language assessments of your child. Follow-up visits may occur every 6-12 months until 36 months of age.
